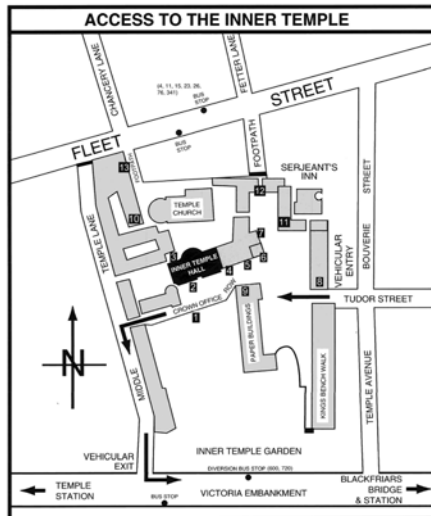
The nearest underground stations are Temple and Blackfriars stations on the Circle and District lines.
